

First National Bank Mobile Deposit FAQ

1. Items that <u>can</u> be deposited

Checks made payable to the account owner or joint owners that have been properly endorsed with "For Mobile Capture Only" and the owner's signature(s).

2. How many items can I deposit each day?

You may deposit 10 items per day.

3. Items that cannot be deposited

No foreign checks

No Bonds

No 3rd party checks

No returned or re-deposited items

No rebate checks

4. How long should check be kept after they are deposited?

Keep checks for 60 days and then destroy them. This allows time to verify the deposit did go through and there were no problems with the image.

5. When will my check be deposited into my account?

Mobile deposited funds are available when you see the transaction within your account activity. All deposits are subject to verification.

Note: Cutoff time for submitting deposits is 4:00 p.m. Central Time (M-F)
